

Terms and Conditions Applicable to Awards Issued under Federal Government Contracts

The University of Michigan is a recipient of a Federal Prime Contract. The Supplier receiving Federal funds as full or partial payment for goods or services must be able to comply with the following Federal Terms and Conditions. These terms and conditions are dictated by the funding agency. The University of Michigan must conform by ensuring that the Supplier understands and can abide by the funding agency requirements. The University of Michigan cannot deviate from or alter the terms and conditions required by the funding agency.

The Supplier agrees, with respect to the award (purchase order, contract, or subcontract), to be bound by the following Federal Acquisition Regulation (FAR) Clauses, incorporated by reference, with the same force and effect, as if they were given in full text.
