

Terms and Conditions Applicable to Awards Issued under Federal Government Grants

The University of Michigan is a recipient of a Federal Prime Grant. The Supplier receiving Federal funds as full or partial payment for goods or services must be able to comply with the following Federal provisions. These terms and conditions are dictated by the funding agency. The University of Michigan must conform by ensuring that the Supplier understands and can abide by the funding agency requirements. The University of Michigan cannot deviate from or alter the terms and conditions required by the funding agency.

The Supplier agrees, with respect to the award (purchase order, contract, or subcontract), to be bound by the Office of Management and Budget (OMB) Circular A-110 (*Uniform Administrative Requirements for Grants and Agreements with Institutions of Higher Education, Hospitals, and other Non-Profit Organizations*), incorporated by reference, with the same force and effect, as if they were given in full text.
